SUBSCRIBER ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Since 1988, Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company has maintained a scholarship fund for the benefit of its members and families. The purpose of the scholarship is to recognize and provide financial assistance to college or trade/technical school students pursuing an education in any degree program of study.

This scholarship award is subject to the following rules and regulations.

1. To be eligible, the candidate must be a Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company subscriber or legally live with a family member who is a subscriber.
2. The candidate must be a senior attending high school, and he/she must have maintained a 3.0 ("B") average over the last three-quarters or two semesters.
3. The recipient must attend a college certified by the *Northwest Accreditation Association or another equivalent regional accreditation association*, or a school recognized by the *Accrediting Commission of Career Schools & Colleges of Technology (ACCSCCT)*.
4. The application must be on the official Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company application form and received by the company by the date designated. Applications received after the deadline but postmarked by the designated date will be accepted. The award(s) will be presented during the company's Annual Meeting in April, which the recipient should attend.
5. A committee appointed by the company's Board of Directors shall select awardees. Applications shall be modified to remove names so a "blind" selection process may be made without influence.
6. Annually the Board of Directors of Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company shall determine the number and amounts of awards. In 2012, there are four awards of \$2,500 each.
7. A recipient is limited to one award.
8. Payment of the award shall be made directly to a recipient upon submission of verified registration at an approved school.

The recipient must attend a college certified by the Northwest Accreditation Association or another equivalent regional accreditation association, or a school recognized by the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools & Colleges of Technology (ACCSCCT).

Planned major field of study

Students are evaluated on seven (7) specific scoring criteria as detailed below. Some areas are weighted more heavily than others. Point assignments are listed next to each criterion. Students are encouraged to **READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY**, as it shows how the Selection Committee scores applications. **Provide your responses to criterion 2 through 7 and attach to this page.**

1. **Application Neatness & Completeness** (10 points) – Applications should be typed, technically accurate (spelling, punctuation, grammar, etc.), thoroughly proofed, and complete.
2. **Education Goals** (20 points) – Outline the goals you have set for your education. Include the factors that led to choosing the schools(s) you plan to attend.
3. **School Activities** (20 points) – Outline school activities in which you have participated and any awards and honors received during high school years. Explain how your school activities have been important in your life.
4. **Contribution to Community** (20 points) – Describe your home and community activities, any work experience and any recognition by others you may have received for your non-school related activities.
5. **Leadership Traits** (10 points) – Describe any leadership experience associated with your home, work, school and community activities.
6. **Personal Statement** (20 points) – Prepare a one-page statement about yourself in such a way that your writing will help the Selection Committee to know and understand you better as a person. Include a statement explaining why you should be selected to receive this scholarship. This statement should be no more than one page.
7. **Academics** (20 points) – Applicants must have maintained a 3.0 (“B”) average over the last three quarters or two semesters. Difficulty of classes taken will be considered as well as the grade received. A complete **transcript of grades and credits** must be presented with this application when submitted.

Applicant must be available to meet with the Selection Committee if selected as a finalist for award, if requested. The awards will be presented during the company's Annual Meeting in April, which the recipient should attend. Recipient must provide verification of high school graduation when disbursement of funds is requested. Recipient will be notified of procedures for disbursement of scholarship funds. Termination of the student's school program will result in the cancellation of the award.
